

RESOLUTION # 515

WHEREAS, Russellville City Ordinance No. 1075 which regulates the use of public and private sewers and drains, private sewage disposal, the installation and connection of building sewers, and the discharge of waters and waste into the public sewer system, and other matters, must be updated in order for the City of Russellville to comply with certain state and federal regulations,

WHEREAS, City Corporation of the City of Russellville will be requesting that the City of Russellville enact an ordinance setting forth uniform requirements for direct and indirect contributors into the wastewater collection and treatment system for the City of Russellville and enabling the city to comply with all applicable state and federal laws required by the Clean Water Act of 1977 and the general pretreatment regulations (40 CFR part 403), a draft of which is attached to and made a part of this resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology must review and approve the proposed ordinance prior to its enactment and requires that the City of Russellville indicate its willingness to enact the same prior to its review and approval by the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that subject to applicable city ordinances and regulations, the City of Russellville hereby approves the submission of the attached ordinance to the Arkansas

Department of Pollution Control and Ecology for its review and approval and hereby indicates its intention to enact the final draft of the ordinance upon its proper presentation to this body.
